Job Description – Project Officer

Overview

Liquid Therapy requires a dedicated and passionate individual to join our team as an Inclusive Surf Therapy Project Officer. This position will be responsible for planning, coordinating, and executing surf therapy sessions with a focus on inclusion and accessibility for individuals with disabilities. The successful candidate will work closely with participants, volunteers, and other team members to ensure a safe and empowering experience for all.

Responsibilities

- Develop and implement an inclusive surf therapy programmes that cater to individuals with additional needs, ensuring all activities are accessible and compliant with safety standards.
- Coordinate and schedule surf therapy sessions, including participant enrolment, volunteer recruitment, and assessment of individual needs.
- Provide support to participants before, during, and after surf therapy sessions, ensuring a safe and inclusive environment that fosters personal growth and empowerment.

- Proven experience in project coordination or program management, preferably in a non-profit or community-based organization.
- Exceptional interpersonal and communication skills, with the ability to connect and build relationships with diverse populations.
- Supporting project administration skills such as communications, budgeting, volunteer management, report writing, graphic design or other relevant skills.

Desirable criteria

- Bachelor's degree in a related field (e.g., Recreation Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Special Education) or equivalent experience and other related qualifications EG: surf instructor, Beach lifeguard, First said, etc.
- Passion for surfing, outdoor activities, and promoting mental health and wellbeing.
- Knowledge of surf therapy or similar therapeutic approaches is desirable.
- Experience of social media, website management and other communications related activities.
- Experience of grant writing and tendering.
- Valid driver's license and access to transportation for program-related activities.
